

SCHOOLS GOVERNED BY THE PEOPLE

The public schools belong to the people. The people govern their schools under rights guaranteed to them by the constitution and statutes of the state of Utah. Governance of the schools is exercised through the elective process and involves three levels of government. The State Legislature; the State Board of Education, and the Local Board of Education. The North Summit Board of Education represents the people in establishing policies and procedures for the conduct of school programs.

The Board is mindful that the people are the ultimate governors of public education and that the Board is directly accountable to the people through the elective process. The public should hold itself accountable for electing the most able men and women available to represent them on the Board of Education, and for providing the resources necessary for the Board and staff to accomplish the goals and objectives of the school district.
