

BOARD COMMITTEES AND ASSIGNMENTS:

The Board shall authorize the President to appoint such special committees as are deemed necessary. The functions of committees shall ordinarily be fact-finding, deliberative, and advisory, and their reports shall be made to the Board for discussion and action. The function of such committees shall be determined by the Board and authorized by special action of the Board. The President of the Board and the Superintendent shall be ex-officio or regular members of all committees. Each committee will be expected to present a report at a regular monthly meeting of the Board. Committees shall be discharged upon completion of their assignments or may be dissolved at any time by majority vote of the Board.

The Board shall have no standing committees. All committees are advisory, and have no power to take action whatsoever, or to commit the Board or district to any course of action, except as specifically directed by the Board.
