

VISITORS POLICY

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The general control and the supervision of the school district is vested in the Board of Education. It is the responsibility of the board to institute a policy that protects the health, safety and welfare of both the students and employees of the school district.

It is therefore the policy of the North Summit School District Board of Education to require that all visitors report to the administrative office of the respective school they are visiting to help eliminate, the disruption of students and/or teachers in their regular classes and eliminate disturbances on the school premises.

The Board of Education charges the principal of their respective building to enforce this policy and see that the necessary measures are taken to inform their respective publics that they must report to the office when visiting the building. They will accomplish this through a proper posting of signs and communicating wherever necessary with visitors that this reporting procedure is the policy of the North Summit School District.

The principals of their respective buildings are also charged with taking the necessary measures to quell any disturbance of disruptions that may occur in their buildings or on their campuses. If they cannot quell these disturbances or disruptions, they will obtain the necessary help from the local law enforcement officers to do so.
