NOTICE REGARDING STEROIDS

The notice regarding legal restrictions on steroids shall be posted in the gymnasium of each District school in which there is a grade level of seven or higher and in each other place in a building where physical education classes are conducted.

Utah Code Ann §58-37-8

Anabolic steroids are controlled substances, and are for medical use only. State law prohibits the possession, delivery, or administering of an anabolic steroid in any manner not allowed by state law. Only a medical doctor may prescribe an anabolic steroid or human growth hormone for a person. A violation of state law concerning anabolic steroids is a criminal offense.

STUDENT CONDUCT

All students are entitled to enjoy the basic rights of citizenship recognized and protected by law for persons of their age and maturity. District schools shall foster a climate of mutual respect for the rights of others in order to enhance the District's educational purpose and the program designed to achieve that purpose. Students shall exercise their rights responsibly in compliance with the rules established for the orderly conduct of the District's educational mission. Students who violate the rights of others or who violate District or school rules shall be subject to disciplinary measures designed to correct the misconduct and promote adherence by all students to the responsibilities of citizens in the school community.

PAGING DEVICES

Students shall not possess a paging device while on school property or while attending a school-sponsored activity on or off school property unless the student is in attendance in the capacity of an active member of a volunteer fire fighting organization or a volunteer emergency medical service organization. A "paging device" is a telecommunications device that emits an audible signal, vibrates, displays a message or otherwise summons or delivers a communication to possessor.

A person who discovers a student in possession of a paging device in violation of this policy shall report the violation to the Principal, who shall order a peace officer or appropriate school employee to confiscate the device, which is forfeited to the District.

DAMAGE

No student shall damage or deface any District building or grounds.
