

## **DRESS AND GROOMING**

Appropriate dress and grooming can influence the attitude of students and thereby influence the learning environment. The Board reserves the right to require that students' dress and grooming are within the limits of decency and generally accepted good taste.

Clothing should be appropriate, neat, clean and inoffensive. Clothing advocating illegal or inappropriate behavior or gang insignia is not to be worn to school. The responsibility for appearance rests primarily with parents and the students themselves. The Board encourages parents and students to maintain high standards of dress and grooming.

Individual schools may develop policies and procedures to insure that student dress and grooming is conducive to a good learning environment. All such policies and procedures must be approved by the Board.
