

CHILD FIND- SPEECH THERAPY:

As the speech- language pathologist for the North Summit School District, I want to make sure I am serving all children ages 3 and up that require speech therapy. Here are some guidelines from the American Speech- Language Hearing Association (asha.org) to let you know if your child may need services:

Hearing and Understanding:

- Hears you when you call from another room.
- Hears television or radio at the same loudness as other family members.
- Answers simple who, what, where and why questions.

Talking:

- Talks about activities at school or friends' homes.
- People outside of the family usually understand child's speech.
- Uses a lot of sentences that have 4 or more words.
- Usually talks easily without repeating syllables or words.

By 3 years of age, your child should be 75-100% understood by their parents.
