

North Summit School District Contingency Plan for the School-Year 2020-21

The North Summit Board of Education has approved this contingency plan.

In the event the Governor orders a school closure due, or if one of our schools has 15 or more cases within a two-week period, we will move our students to remote learning. Teachers will instruct from their classrooms. This will allow our IT Director, his assistants, and the Instructional Coach to provide immediate technical assistance to the teachers. The administrators will be available to provide instructional leadership and support to the teachers. Counselors will continue their duties as scheduled only in a virtual setting. We will allow students with disabilities to come to the school and receive services. We will also allow small groups of students in the school to meet with teachers for extra help or for testing purposes. Paraprofessionals will be assigned to teachers to help them communicate and tutor students who need help. Food Service will prepare grab and go breakfast/lunches for students to pick up daily. Bus Drivers will be available to deliver lunches if necessary and to deliver devices, lesson materials, etc. to homes if necessary. Custodians will deep clean and sanitize buildings and perform regular classroom cleanings for teachers. Office staff in each building will continue to perform their regular duties as assigned by their principals.
