**North Summit School District employs individuals holding an LEA- Specific Educator License, license area, and/or endorsement.**

**USBE License types include:**

**Professional:** A license issued to an individual who has demonstrated all of the State established competencies to be an educator. The requirements for a professional educator license are outlined in R277-301-5.

**Associate:** a license issued to an individual completing the requirements to receive a Professional Educator License. Individuals may be working as an intern, enrolled in a university program, enrolled in a career and technical education (CTE), or an Alternate Pathway to Professional Educator License (APPEL). The requirements of an associate educator license are outlined in R277-301-4. An associate educator license, license area, or endorsement is valid for two years.

**LEA-Specific:** An individual, approved by the Board of Education who has met locally defined competencies to be an educator, and approved by LEA application to USBE.
